## **Edgren High School Academic Scholarship Application**

The Misawa Officers Spouses' Club is again offering academic and vocational scholarships to be awarded to eligible high school seniors. To be eligible to compete for an academic scholarship, the student must have a grade point average of at least 3.0 and be planning to attend a four-year college or university full-time beginning in the **2010** fall semester. Any senior who attended Edgren High School at least one semester or is graduating from Edgren High School is eligible for the MOSC academic scholarship.

Students interested in applying for the academic scholarship will submit all the following to **Brenda Reed**, Box **2426** no later than the deadline:

- Completed application (attached to this letter)

Applications can be hand written, but typed is preferred. Essay must be typed.

GPA will be filled in on Page 2 by a school official

Page 2 of the application will be signed by a school official

- Official high school transcript
- Copy of all of the student's SAT and/or ACT score reports
- Two letters of recommendation (recommendation forms are attached)

At least one from school faculty or work supervisor

Mailed to: **Brenda Reed**, Box **2426**

- In a sealed envelope by person making recommendation
- Prior to the deadline (**April 16, 2010**)

Last name of applicant will be on the outside lower left corner of the envelope

Recommendations may NOT be made by parents or relatives

The applicant is responsible for proving all necessary information. Incomplete applications will not be eligible for consideration. The applicant may attach additional pages as needed to provide detailed explanation for questions on the application.

Prior to fund disbursement, scholarship recipients will submit proof of full-time enrollment in a college or university to the Misawa Officers Spouses' Club Scholarship Committee. Scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to the school.

Scholarship selections will be announced at the MOSC May Dinner and at Edgren High School Award's Ceremony.

Applicants who receive an appointment to a service academy will be ineligible to receive a Misawa Officers Spouses' Club scholarship. However, such applicants will still be honored as a Misawa Officers Spouses' Club scholar at the MOSC May Dinner and at the Edgren High School Award's Ceremony.
