MOSC ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The MOSC is currently accepting applications for our annual MOSC High School Academic Scholarships and MOSC Continuing Education Scholarships. The MOSC has up to \$30,000 to give away to eligible scholarship recipients.



The High School Scholarship recipients:

- Must be a graduating high school senior enrolled at Edgren High School having completed at least one semester at EHS.
- Must have 3.0 or higher cumulative grade point average (GPA) and planning to attend a four-year college or university full-time beginning in the 2014 fall semester.
- Must provide SAT or ACT scores.

The MOSC Continuing Education Scholarship recipient:

- Must be non-military spouses and dependents of:
 - *Members of the U.S. Armed Forces to include retired members
 - *Department of Defense Civilian Component
- Must meet the citizenry requirements expressed in the Status of Forces Agreement
 Articles I (a), (b), and (c). The definitions of "member of U.S. Armed Forces", "DOD
 Civilian Component", and "Dependent" are taken from the US-Japan SOFA agreement
 and listed below.
- Can be Seniors graduating from an accredited home school program during the 2013-2014 school year, planning to attend an accredited institution within the 2014-2015 school year are eligible.
- Can be a continuing education applicant if planning on continuing to reside on Misawa Air Force Base, or in the local areas of and surrounding Misawa City, Japan to be eligible for the MOSC Continuing Education Scholarship.

All you need to do is complete an application. You can find the application online at our website www.misawaosc.org or pick up an application at the High School Counselor's Office. Once the application is filled out completely, you can place it in the locked box at the Thrift Shop or the High School Office. You can also mail the application to:
